

Thank you for requesting OneDrumm to attend your event, we are honored to share the medicine of the drum and our sacred songs. We travel with 9 members and 1 sound technician and come in the spirit of service offering our smoke, medicine songs and prayers.

Here are some the things will help us attend:

- Schedule** If possible please share your dates, location and event schedule as early as possible so we can ensure all members are available to attend.
- The Land** If possible please let us know the of the local tribes so we may honor them and call our ancestors to hold space for success of the event.
- Sacred smoke** We will burn tobacco, cedar, sage, sweetgrass or copal at each of our drum ceremonies as sacred smoke is the medicine of our people and we can't share our songs without it.
- Coming in a good way** If it feels needed, you may let other tribal members participating in the event know that we come as women on the ceremonial drum and also dance if inspired. As an inner tribal women's group, our medicine is shared in this way. Please assure others that we mean no disrespect to their individual traditions that may not agree with women on the drum or dancing.
- Sound System** We travel with a small PA system and 2 microphones; for larger events we ask to plug into your existing system.
- Seating** We ask if you can provide 10 chairs and a small table to help reduce the amount needed in our travel car.
- The Drums** If possible, we ask for a covered place to store our drums when not in ceremony.
- Lodging** If overnight stay is required, we ask for 3 lodging rooms with 2 queen beds or Glamping accommodations.
- Fuel & food** We ask that fuel and food costs be covered when travel is more than 100 miles.
- Air Travel** If air travel is required, we ask that all travel expenses, as well as airport pick-up and drop off be provided.
- Expenses** We ask for an offering of \$1200 to cover personal expenses such as bus rental, baby-sitting, elder-care, pet-care, etc., so all members can attend.
- Offerings** We do not charge to drum during Ceremony, however if you are inclined offer an additional tax deductible donation to our non-profit, we will gladly accept to help support our continued good work in the indigenous community.

We thank you in advance for allowing OneDrumm to be part of your sacred event.
